In order to serve the schools that have already signed up for Project Reads, we once again need 100+ volunteers. Our aim is to have all Project Read's sites up and running shortly after the start of the new school year. No prior experience is necessary, just a desire to be a positive influence in a child's life who needs extra help with literacy! Initial and ongoing training will be provided throughout the program year.

What is it like volunteering for Project Reads?

Project Reads volunteers conduct one-hour weekly meetings on a specific day of the week. Sessions take place immediately after dismissal at each school; start times vary from 2:30 pm to 3:45 pm Monday through Thursday. Volunteers typically work with one student for the entire school year. This allows volunteers and students to form an important and beneficial bond.

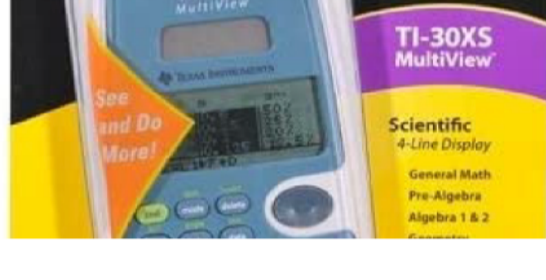
