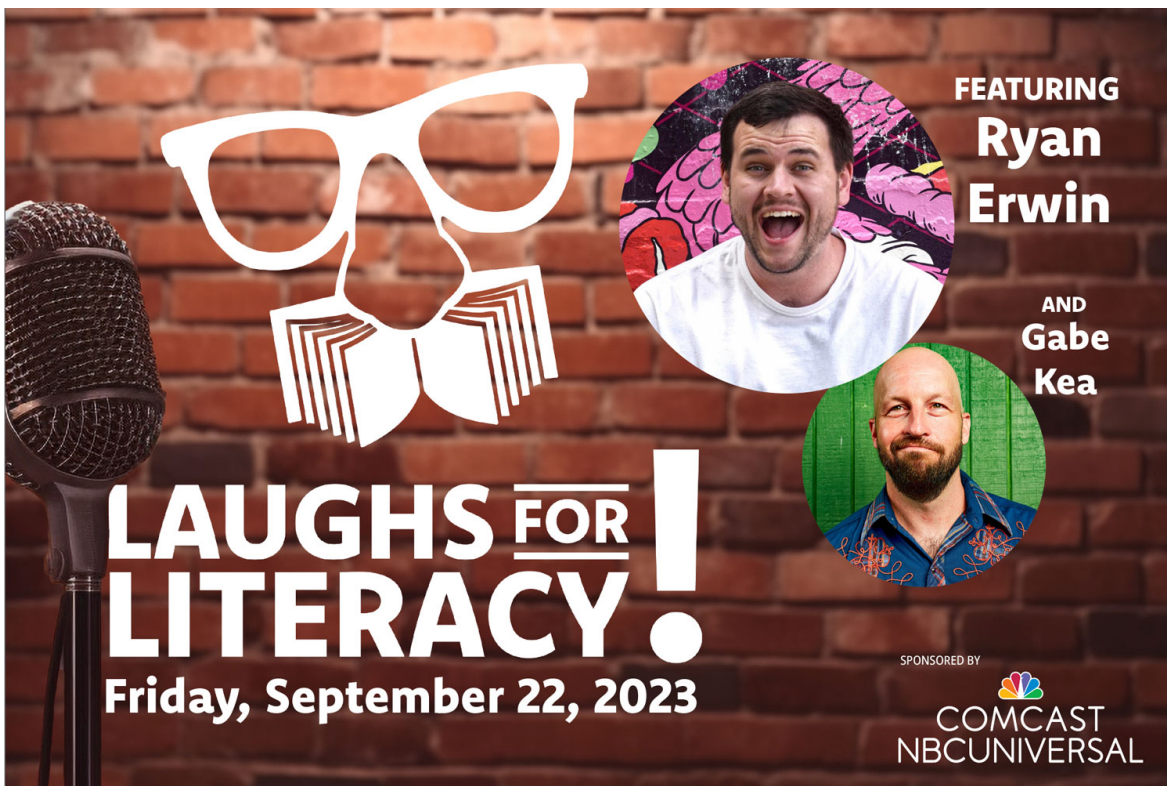

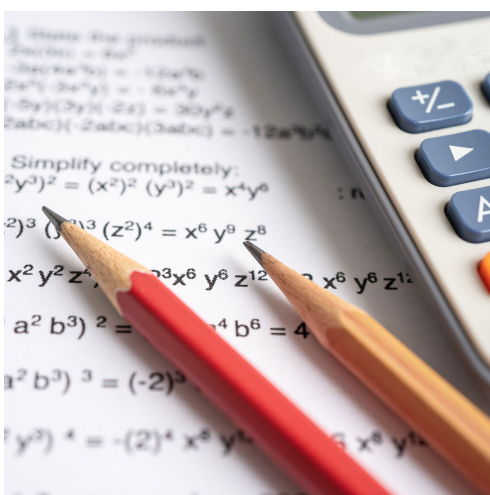
Tickets Are Now Available!

Can You Help Our Students Get GED Ready?

The state of Indiana recently resumed offering the GED as a high school equivalency (HSE) testing option. Students prepare for this test in our HSE classrooms via teacher-guided lessons and independent study. When students demonstrate proficiency in each subject, they take a pre-test, otherwise known as a “GED Ready” test. These assessments are valuable tools. They provide students with a probable GED score for each subject and offer

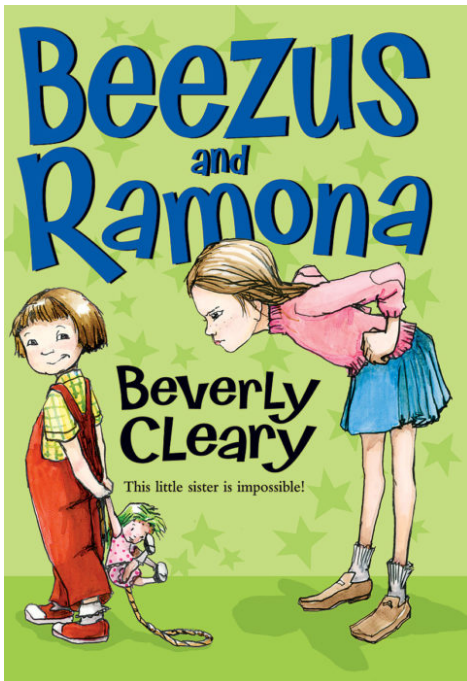

Ages 4-9 | 176 pages | Grade level 3-7

Newbery Award winner Beverly Cleary delivers a humorous portrayal of the ups and downs of sisterhood. Both the younger and older siblings of the family will enjoy this book.

Having a little sister like four-year-old Ramona isn't always easy for Beezus Quimby. With a wild imagination, disregard for order, and an appetite for chaos, Ramona makes it hard for Beezus to be the responsible older sister she knows she ought to be...especially when Ramona threatens

What is it like volunteering for Project Reads?

Project Reads volunteers conduct one-hour weekly meetings on a specific day of the week. Sessions take place immediately after dismissal at each school; start times vary from 2:30 pm to 3:45 pm Monday through Thursday. Volunteers typically work with one student for the entire school year. This allows volunteers and students to form an important and beneficial bond.
